3. PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING ACTIVITY

To perform a Study on the implementation and potential improvement of the REACH/CLP Defence Exemption mechanisms established by EU Ministries of Defence, EDA will circulate a questionnaire to NAD Points of Contact and EU Member States REACH experts.

4. DATA PROCESSED

(a) Data subject categories:

- Representatives of EU Member States' Ministries of Defence or related public authorities
- EU Member States REACH experts

(b) Data categories processed:

- first name and surname,
- title and organisation/ employer
- contact details: email, telephone number

5. RECIPIENTS OF THE DATA

The internal recipients of the personal data are EDA staff members directly involved in the performance of the study. Other EDA staff could obtain access on a need-to-know basis.

External recipients are the Data Processor and in particular the staff involved in the study.

6. PROTECTION AND SAFEGUARDING OF THE DATA

EDA has implemented appropriate technical and organisational measures (firewalls, checkpoints, antivirus) to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risks represented by the processing and the nature of the personal data to be protected. Such measures have been taken in particular to prevent any unauthorised disclosure or access, accidental or unlawful destruction or accidental loss, or alteration and to prevent all others unlawful forms of processing.

7. RIGHT OF ACCESS AND RECTIFICATION OF THE DATA

Data subjects have the right to access their personal data, the right to request rectification of any inaccurate or incomplete personal data, the right to erasure, the right to restriction of processing, the right to object to the processing, the right to not be subject to automated decision making, as applicable and at any time.

8. RETENTION OF THE DATA

Personal data will be retained for up to 1 year from the initiation of the activity.

Aggregated reports, containing anonymised data only, may be kept for an unlimited time.

9. LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING OPERATION

The legal basis for the data processing is Article 5(a) of Regulation (EC) 2018/1725. Processing of personal data of NAD Points of Contacts and MS REACH Experts is necessary for the performance of tasks carried out in the public interest by EDA, and in particular for EDA to carry out its tasks, as provided by Article 5 of the Council Decision (CFSP) 2015/1835.
